<p>Kommentar zur Veranstaltung:</p> <p>This lecture series will present you with principal theoretical frameworks for the study of texts, on the one hand, and with methods and tools for the practical analysis of texts on the other. The lectures will move from narrowly linguistic and text-centred theories to wider, culturalist paradigms. The different theoretical frameworks will be shown to yield different, though often complementary methods for the practical analysis of texts. The lectures will focus on literary texts in particular and consider the significance of genre in literature. You will be introduced to analytical tools for approaching prose, dramatic and lyrical texts. Yet the lectures will also problematize the notion of the ‘text’ in relation to different media.</p> <p>This lecture-series forms an obligatory part of the Introductory Module. In the accompanying Introductory Course (Ia) you will have the opportunity to apply and test the concepts and tools discussed in this lecture series as you analyse individual literary texts.</p>
