Course description

Your aim will be to extend the range of structures and vocabulary that you have at your disposal when writing in a formal academic style. You will be writing short pieces (150 - 200 words) each week and will write three in-class essays.

Assessment for the course will be on these three essays. There will be two in-class essay exercises of 2-hours each plus one 3-hour essay writing exercise. The latter exercise will be split over two successive weeks and will consist of a 1-hour brainstorming and lexical field preparation session followed by a 2-hour essay writing session the week after. Each essay will be 450-550 words in length. The first two essays will each count for 30% of the grade and the third essay will count for 40% of the grade.
