“Evolving English”: a British Library exhibition delves into where English came from and where it’s going.

This course will explore elements of history and development, oral traditions, and the changing nature of the English language to show that there is *no one simple story*. A focus will be placed on the British Library’s exhibition in 2010 on “Evolving English”. Through the use of literature, podcasts, interviews, and film, students will be encouraged to consider this pragmatic and whimsical journey through reading and written assignments.

Assessment: will be based on a group project, reading tasks, in-class writing and three graded assignments. To qualify for a course credit, participation and attendance is required, as well as the successful completion of all graded assignments.
