<p><b>Course description:</b></p> <p>This is an introductory course to Linguistics. The primary aim of this class is to give basic ideas of the fields of Linguistics rather than detailed expositions. Thus, a short overview of the development of Linguistics as a science will lead us from Historical Linguistics to Linguistics after de Saussure. At this point, we will look at communication models and some further underpinnings of Semiotics. While keeping an eye on the impact of Linguistics on other sciences in the last century, we work our way through the very essential principles of Phonetics, Phonology, Morphology, Syntax and Semantics. Having studied the basic definitions and techniques to approach language scientifically, we are ready to look at some more recent developments of linguistic investigation in Psycholinguistics, Sociolinguistics and Computational Linguistics. To make it an enjoyable experience for all of us, students are expected to participate actively in class and do the assigned readings.</p>
