Course description:

In this seminar you will read excerpts from different writings that reflect on theory and method, and you will apply their insights to the analysis of a selection of primary texts. You will focus, in particular, on the relation between texts and other media. You will distinguish the different forms this relation may take, such as intertextual relations to other media, media combination (multimedia), and media change. You will acquire tools for analysing the different relations between texts and other media, and you will explore the complexities of these forms in specific historical and cultural contexts.

The examples will be taken from British and American literature and culture and they will cut across narrative fiction, drama/performance, and film.

A reader will be provided at the beginning of the seminar.
