<p>Course description:</p> <p>The course introduces the multifaceted field of bilingualism and multilingualism in light of the remarkable increase of language contacts in the modern world.</p> <p>The contents of the course cover bilingualism and multilingualism from various perspectives: linguistic, socio-economic, historical, cognitive, and educational. Furthermore, the course examines language policies and ideologies, the question of language and identity of bi-/multilingual speakers, possible advantages and disadvantages and the rise of metalinguistic awareness of users of two (or more) languages. In addition, the linguistic phenomena of code-switching and code-mixing are examined and the main concepts such as bilingualism, diglossia, language maintenance, heritage languages, language planning are introduced. Finally, the course offers some practical implications of the research in the field of bilingualism and multilingualism.</p> <p>This seminar takes into consideration the academic and professional needs of students. Participants of the seminar can explore various case studies and data depending to their interests, background, experiences and programme of study.</p>
