In this seminar, we will read Ralph Ellison's novel *Invisible Man* (1952), a masterpiece of African American writing and arguably one of the most important novels of the twentieth century. We will discuss the book's publication history, its role as an inspiration for other authors and artists, and, above all, *we will read it closely* – chapter by chapter, from the first sentence to the last. We will compare reading techniques, sharpen our interpretative skills, and (re)acquaint ourselves with the satisfying task of diligently working through a text in its entirety.
