This seminar is for MEd students only.

In this course you will have the opportunity to explore a number of methods and activities that you can use in school to involve all students in your classroom, to give them more opportunities to practice and improve their language skills and in some cases also to develop their critical thinking skills. Planning your own lessons and assuming the role of students in your fellow students' lessons will help you to hone your skills when it comes to structuring lessons, giving instructions, designing materials, correcting errors and dealing with other aspects of teaching. As in all Sprachpraxis courses, regular attendance is mandatory.

All students are required to plan and teach two lesson simulations ('mini-lessons') together with a team partner. Learning objectives and topics for the mini-lessons should be chosen in accordance with the requirements of the *Bildungsplan Englisch* for your specialisation, and your lesson should demonstrate a method that is in line with a communicative approach to language teaching and also have a clear language focus (details will be supplied in class).

Graded work for IAA51 (3 LP):

- in-class writing assignment (20% of final grade)
- first lesson simulation, including uploading a short lesson plan and the lesson materials (30% of final grade)
- second lesson simulation, including uploading a short lesson plan, the lesson materials and an analysis/reflection of 800-1000 words, written and submitted individually (40%)
- participation grade (10%)

Graded work for ENG 19a/b (5 or 4 LP):

- in-class writing assignment (20% of final grade)
- first lesson simulation, including lesson plan, lesson materials and an analysis/reflection of 800-1000 words for LAGym/LAS (ENG19a) or 300-400 words for LAPS (ENG19b), submitted individually (40%)
- second lesson simulation, including lesson plan, lesson materials and an analysis/reflection of 800-1000 words, written and submitted individually (40%)
