Kommentar zur Veranstaltung:

What are postcolonial literatures? What does the term “postcolonial” imply? How does literature relate to post-colonial theory? How do literary texts from the former colonies respond to the established canon of English literature? What happens to language in postcolonial texts? What happens to history and its narration?

In this class, we will engage with both postcolonial theory and literature. The seminar will be divided into several blocks which correspond to important concepts in postcolonial theory, such as “writing back” or hybridity. After reading and discussing a theoretical essay for each concept, we will then read short stories which exemplify or respond to these concepts.
