Course description:

The purpose of the introduction is to make you familiar with approaches to literary texts within the general framework of scientific discourse. The following aspects are going to be highlighted:

- Discussion of key concepts and working techniques
- Discussion of the concepts “literature”, “literary criticism”, “literary science”
- Purposes and genres of literary texts (poetics)
- Introduction to the textual analysis of poetry, drama and narrative fiction
- Introduction to other modes of literary writing
- Literary stylistic devices

A reader with texts, excerpts and materials will be provided.

Participating in the tutorial meetings is mandatory. The course is in English, and it is complemented by the lecture on the *History of British Literature*.
