Course description:

This course will familiarize students with theoretical aspects of English pronunciation; practice the use of transcription to note details of pronunciation; and enable students to present a range of oral texts confidently and clearly. In oral work emphasis will be placed on students' ability to engage and entertain their audience.

To pass the course students must have a good working knowledge of theory, be able to read and complete short transcriptions, and be able to present a text in an easily comprehensible accent of English that is not too highly coloured by their native language/would constitute a good model for learners. Features of connected speech must be used with good fluency and consistency and there must be no more than occasional slips in the pronunciation of words.
