## **Course description:**

This course will introduce students to basic theoretical concepts of corpus linguistics and the practical application of empirical corpus-based approaches to the study linguistic variation.

During this course students will explore how to use different software applications in order to answer research questions or to simply explore corpus data. Thus, this course focuses on how to extract, process, visualize, and analyze existing corpus data as well as what needs to be considered when creating one's own corpus. To successfully pass this course, students have to participate regularly and actively, hand-in minor assignments and complete a project which consists of (i) a term paper which uses corpus data to answer a research question, or (ii) compile a corpus and provide documentation for that corpus.
