## **Description:**

This course will examine the structure of English words, phrases, clauses and sentences and discuss approaches which aim to explain how these units are formed. The part of this course which focuses on morphology aims to determine how and why speakers of a language compose words the way they do. In addition to providing a more in-depth look at morphology in general, we will focus more specifically on how speakers of English use morphological processes to convey grammatical information. The other part of this course focuses on syntax, i.e. the branch of linguistics which studies the structure of phrases, clauses and sentences. In the syntax sessions, we will examine how to describe the structures we can observe in English and explore different theoretical approaches which inform our understanding of the structure and workings of English. Since this course also aims at providing you with the necessary practical tools to perform linguistics analyzes on your own, we will consider corpora to investigate morphological and syntactic phenomena.
