Course description

This course familiarizes students with skills and methods necessary for the study of British literature and culture. It covers literary forms, styles, techniques, and also touches on key theoretical approaches and critical practices. In doing so, the seminar provides an introduction to careful textual analysis and to the critical and historical understanding this requires. The course also explores fundamental issues of literary history, literature as an institution, processes of periodization and canonization, and illustrates these through examples and case studies. The basics of scholarly research will also be addressed.
