In the age of the omnipresence of the media Ernest Hemingway's personal life and œuvre have intertwined almost indistinguishably. By a close reading of Hemingway's posthumous novels *A Moveable Feast*, *Islands in the Stream* and *The Garden of Eden* we will try to unveil Hemingway, the writer, behind his public persona. *The Garden of Eden*, in particular, confronts the reader with an unknown Hemingway who experimented with the traditional definitions of gender.

Aside from the analysis and interpretation of Hemingway's novels and short stories we will also discuss the problematics of posthumous editing and the effect of the mass media on the the creditability of a writer.
