### **Course Description:**

This course is aimed at B.A. and M.A. students who are close to their final exams and are currently preparing their theses. The *Kolloquium* will therefore try to address the specific problems that students may encounter during the final phase of their degrees. Individual sessions may be dedicated to

- the revision of British literary history in its cultural contexts,
- the discussion of thesis structure and general argument,
- the development of possible exam topics and
- the staging of a mock exam.

Most importantly, students will get the chance to develop research questions and test their ideas and arguments in a congenial setting. All participants must contribute to this course with presentations of their research. Students will also be expected to provide constructive criticism of their peers' work.
