Course description:

Welcome to Introduction to British Literature and Culture! In this course, we will talk about the key concepts of the study of literature and culture. We will explore the basic methods and theoretical underpinnings of textual analysis and use both to explore selected texts from poetry, prose and drama. Students will not only learn how to approach and analyse literary texts academically, but also how to transfer their ideas into writing and are required to keep a reading journal to record their ideas and responses to both literary and academic texts we will read throughout the course. At the end of the semester, students will thus be acquainted as much with basic literary analysis as with the requirements of presenting their ideas in an academic context.
