<p><b>Course description:</b></p> <p>This course is devoted to the study of the structure of words and of the various processes that we use in English to create new words. While introductory courses to linguistics can only provide an overview of the different types of word formation that exist in English, we will here deal in much greater detail with the processes of derivation and compounding. We will see what empirical data can contribute to answer such theoretical questions as to where the ‘head’ of a word is located and which approaches linguists have come up with to describe the interactions that take place between morphology, syntax and phonology.</p> <p>In the first part of this course, we will elaborate on such basic concepts as the word, the morpheme and the lexeme and explore e.g. the different types of affixes that English provides us with. We will also discuss the concept of productivity and compare how productive the individual processes of word formation are. In the second part of the course, students are expected to team up in groups and give their own presentations in class (held via zoom). The topics for presentation include: compounding, clipping, comparative formation, the distinction between words and phrases.
