**Kommentar:**

In this course we will examine language use in interaction, involving topics and authentic texts from sociolinguistics, psycholinguistics and conversational analysis. The topics will include maxims of cooperation, turn-taking systematics, non-verbal communication and gender differences. Texts will include demanding sociolinguistic articles as well as transcripts of naturally-occurring conversations, interviews and video. Exercises will focus on academic reading skills, data-collecting, transcribing and analysis, as well as on improving oral proficiency. Students will be required to carefully research and write an academic paper analysing original transcribed data, and to present their results orally in a "mini-colloquium".
