<p><b>Course description:</b></p> <p>This lecture series accompanies the introductory seminars and introduces you to the study of literary texts. What is literature? What kind of discipline is English studies / American studies, and where does it come from? The lectures will address and explain basic concepts in the field, and they will present you with methods for the analysis of texts. The survey will cover, in particular, methods and ways of analysis for the genres of prose fiction, poetry, and drama. These methods include narratological and rhetorical terms. Yet they also encompass ways of describing the interrelation between texts, and between texts and the culture in which they are embedded. You will see the methods and terms of analysis applied in examples, and you will be guided to relevant material for further studies.</p>
