<p>Course description:</p> <p>In the course of this seminar students will learn to apply theoretical concepts as well as practical methods and terms in their analysis of literary texts. Taking up some of the key-terms of the lecture series <i>Grundlagen der Anglistischen und Amerikanistischen Literaturwissenschaft</i> the class will engage in close readings of individual poems, prose texts and dramas from British Literature. The participants will acquire the skills of practical analysis as they study texts from the sixteenth century to the present, focusing both on literary and cultural aspects. In addition students will learn how to find useful secondary material for their assignments and how to meet the formal requirements of a seminar paper. A reader will be available at the beginning of the semester.</p> <p>Credit requirements: regular attendance, active participation, written examination at the end of the seminar.</p>
