Course description:

The purpose of the introduction is to make you familiar with approaches to literary texts within the general framework of scientific discourse. Understanding texts and evaluating their function is the first step to discuss their cultural framework critically. The following aspects will be highlighted:

- Discussion of key concepts and working techniques
- Discussion of the concepts "literature", "literary criticism", and "philology"
- Purposes and genres of literary texts and stylistic devices (poetics)
- Introduction to modes of literary writing
- Introduction to British culture (Shakespeare, English sonnet, film, other media, discourse)

A reader with texts, excerpts and materials will be provided.

Participating in the tutorial meetings is mandatory. The course is in English, and it is complemented by the lecture on the *History of British Literature*. This course, however, will approach texts and the media in a systematic way, focussing especially on the textual analysis of poetry, drama and narrative fiction.
