<p>This course introduces students to basic concepts of a modern syntactic theory, i.e. Construction Grammar (CG) but also briefly discusses basic aspects of X-bar theory, which represents a formal approach towards syntax. However, the focus is strictly placed on usage-based theories of grammar (CG) and their application to English. In addition, the course introduces students to investigating grammatical variation and change by including workshop-like sessions which exemplify practical hands-on analyses of corpus data. Students are provided with the relevant literature at the beginning of the term.</p>
