

Clare Hanson is a Professor of English at the University of Southampton. Her principal research interests are women's writing and the relationship between literature and science (*A Cultural History of Pregnancy* (2004) and *Eugenics, Literature and Culture in Post-war Britain* (2012)). In her lecture, she will address a topic from the context of her most current research that focuses on the cultural implications of post-genomic science for understandings of inheritance and identity.
