WS 2025/26 Creative Writing

How the courses work

Students will learn in small, intensive groups of 15 students. Each session combines three key elements:

- 1. Reading and discussion of texts in different genres,
- 2. Practical writing exercises designed to harness creativity and develop craft,
- 3. **Workshopping and feedback**, where students share their writing with their peers and receive constructive responses from both the group and the tutor.

In addition, students will be asked to complete writing exercises at home and will have the opportunity to receive **individual feedback and one-to-one guidance** from Dr Lehnen.

Assessment will take the form of a creative portfolio: a short story or essay of up to 1,000 words, 30 lines of poetry, or 5–10 pages of script. While the work will not be graded, students will benefit from in-depth, personalised feedback.

What you can write

The programme offers intensive courses in:

- the short story,
- the novel,
- essays, journalism, and narrative non-fiction.

There will also be introductory sessions ("Schnuppertage") for those who wish to explore Creative Writing for the first time, and two 'Blockkurse' for students who wish to explore multiple genres of creative writing, e. g. short stories and poetry.

In all courses, students will have the chance to reflect not only on their own creative practice, but also on the practice of established and emerging writers as well as topical questions such as the role of **Artificial Intelligence in writing and creativity.**
