

Call for Papers: Workshop on Samoyedic Languages and Cultures

Dear colleagues,

In the closing discussion of the 8th International conference on Samoyedic Studies held in Tomsk in September, it was decided that in 2022 there will be no regular edition of the conference series. Instead, a **Workshop on Samoyedic Languages and Cultures** will take place in **Hamburg** on **8–9 September 2022**. We hope that the pandemic situation will still improve until then, nevertheless, we plan with a hybrid event given possible travel restrictions.

We invite contributions that address any topic in the field of Samoyedic studies in two formats:

- Regular talk, which will be allowed 20 minutes of presentation time, followed by 10 minutes of discussion.
- Free discussion slots, which will be given 30 minutes of time. The idea of this format is to provide the possibility to discuss current topics of Your work in a circle of experts. Therefore, the topic and the issue to discuss should be shortly (5 minutes) be introduced by the presenter, but NOT be lengthily presented like in a regular talk.

Abstract submission

We invite anonymous abstracts for both regular talks and free discussion slots. In the former case, the abstract should not exceed 300 words (excluding references), using 1in/2.5cm margins, line spacing 1.5 and a standard 12pt font. In the latter case, the abstract might be even shorter, but the topic of the discussion slot should be introduced so that participants can eventually prepare themselves.

One person may submit maximally two abstracts (one as a single author or co-author, and another one as a co-author) regardless of the format chosen. Abstracts should be submitted to the conference e-mail address (ifuu@uni-hamburg.de) by 28 February 2022.

In the body of your mail please indicate:

- your name
- title of the paper
- format of the contribution (regular talk or free discussion)
- your affiliation
- your e-mail
- if you need an invitation (including the one for a visa)
- if you know already: whether you will be here in person or whether you will participate online

There will most probably be no conference fee.
