Lectureship in the Eastern European Studies at the University of Hamburg for the winter semester 2021/22:

Project Seminar Master's Program in Eastern European Studies 2 SWS, date by agreement (block seminar possible); teaching language: German or English

The project seminar is located in the subject area of the lecture series of Eastern European Studies in winter term 2021/22: "Zwischen Umweltzerstörung und ländlicher Idylle: Osteuropa in ökologischer Perspektive" (Between Environmental Destruction and Rural Idyll: Eastern Europe in Ecological Perspective) (Wed, 4-6pm, starting 10/27/2021). Together with the introductory seminar and the lecture series, it constitutes the core module of the Master's program in Eastern European Studies. This mandatory courses provide students with insights into a cross-disciplinary understanding of the target region. By developing an interdisciplinary approach to current issues, they are enabled to deal comparatively with the methods, research approaches and research literature of the disciplines associated with Eastern European Studies.

In the project seminar, students deepen the knowledge they have acquired and apply it in a concrete working context. They gain experience with the conceptual and organizational planning of a scientific project, its implementation as well as the documentation of results (project report, online presentation or similar).

Requirements:

- 1) Degree in Eastern European Studies, Slavic Studies, History, Ethnology or a degree with comparable relevance to the subject matter
- 2) Project experience in the field of Eastern European Studies and/or Eastern Europe
- 3) Teaching experience and/or didactic qualification
